**Subject: - Issuance of Letter of Intent to The Chairman, Sanskar Shiksha Samiti, VPO-Sunderpur, The-Behat, Dist-Saharanpur-247662, Uttar Pradesh in respect of application/scheme received vide ref no. SSS/BAMS/New/01/2022-23 dated 26.10.2021 to establish new Ayurveda Medical College in the name of Saharanpur Ayurved Medical College, VPO-Sansarpur, Tehsil-Behat, Dist-Saharanpur-247129, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID-AYU0733) with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course from the academic session 2022-23 under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder in respect of the appeal dated 28.11.2022 -regarding.**

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act,1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been dissolved. Further, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government notified that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021.

This is with reference to the first appeal filed by the **Chairman, Sanskar Shiksha Samiti, VPO-Sunderpur, The-Behat, Dist-Saharanpur-247662, Uttar Pradesh vide letter ref. no SSS/BAMS/New/04/2022-23 dated 28.11.2022** to the commission in respect of denial of Letter of Intent issued to **The Chairman, Sanskar Shiksha Samiti, VPO-Sunderpur, The-Behat, Dist-Saharanpur-247662, Uttar Pradesh to establish new Ayurveda Medical College in the name of Saharanpur Ayurved Medical College, VPO-Sansarpur, Tehsil-Behat, Dist-Saharanpur-247129, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID-AYU0733) with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 from the academic session 2022-23** by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, National Commission for Indian System of Medicine due to not fulfilling the criteria as mentioned in denial order letter of even no. dated 15.11.2022.

1. Thereafter the said appeal was placed before the Chairman, NCISM and Chairman NCISM constituted a Hearing Committee and provided an opportunity of hearing to the college. Accordingly, the letter was sent to the **Chairman, Sanskar Shiksha Samiti, VPO-Sunderpur, The-Behat, Dist-Saharanpur-247662, Uttar Pradesh** vide commission letter no. **NCISM/Comm./Appeal/(2022-23) (U.P.) dated 01.12.2022** to appear before the designated hearing committee on **02.12.2022** in respect of appeal filed under section 24(3) of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020 and to produce all relevant valid documents/records/ proof to substantiate the claims and make written submission and submit an authenticated copy of evidence/verifications to commission with shortcoming wise clarifications mentioned in the denial order dated **15.11.2022** passed by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM. The proceeding of appeal was held virtually on **02.12.2022 at 11:00 am** and on behalf of college, **Dr. Deepak Deshpande, Principal and Mr. Dev Lal Chaudhary, management attended the hearing.**
2. The hearing committee sought clarification from the representatives of college regarding shortcomings mentioned in the denial order dated **15.11.2022** passed by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM, which are as under:-

<p>application, having appropriate number of beds, bed occupancy and Out-Patient Department attendance corresponding to the annual students intake capacity as specified in the sub-regulation (2) of regulation 7".</p> <p>It is pertinent to mention here that:</p> <p>The college was asked to submit the bank remitted salary statement of individual Hospital staff for the previous two years before the last date of submission of application Le, 31.10.2021, to prove the existence of a fully functional hospital for last two years. In response, the College has submitted the Punjab National Bank statement of Trust namely Sanskar Shiksha Samiti for the period of 19 months (05.04.2020 to 31.10.2021) and the salary disbursement statement of staffs in the trust letter head with Bank seal (Punjab National Bank) for the period of 20 months (March- 2020 to Oct-2021), hence the deficiency of 4 months (Nov 2019-Feb 2020) is persisting. Individual salary paid bank statement of all hospital staffs for the said period has not been submitted.</p> <p>Hence, the college is not fulfilling the required criteria for issuance of Letter of Intent mentioned in the Regulation 10 (a) (i) MSR-2016 as it has not provided sufficient documents/evidence to prove the existence of a fully functional hospital prior two years from the date of application.</p>	<p>submitted all relevant documents through E-mail &amp; virtual submission. No. 3-4/MARB/2022-Ay (155) dated. 15-11-2022 has been issued to college stating that-</p> <p>Salary statement in proper format for previous 2 years has not been submitted by the college and the existence of fully functional hospital for last two years is not substantiated.</p> <p>In this matter it was mentioned that college has submitted 19 months (05-04-2020 to 31-10-2021) bank statement and salary disbursement statement of staff. Hence the deficiency of 4 months (Nov 2019 – Feb 2020) is persisting. Individual salary paid bank statement of all hospital staffs for the said period has not been submitted. Letter attached is (Annexure-III).</p> <p>In this regard, we have to say that-</p> <p>1. The college has submitted bank statement of trust and the salary disbursement letter of staff, verified by the Punjab national bank.</p> <p>We also want to state that college has all the bank statements since Nov 2019 to till date. Previous two years (November 2019 to December 2021) bank statements including the statement mentioned in denial letter are attached herewith as (Annexure-IV).</p> <p>2. College has all staff individual bank statements. However, the Salary disbursement statement and also the Salary Acquaintance register was submitted by the college. The submission was verified and can be considered.</li> <li>• Individual salary paid bank passbook details of 76 hospital staffs for the period (1/11/2019 to 31/10/2021) has submitted by the college and after verification it is found that 08 individual statements are incomplete. However, submission can be considered.</li> <li>• The College authorities has submitted the joining letter as well as relieving letter of Dr. Maheshwar Dash and Dr.G.C Pachauri. The submission was verified and can be considered.</li> </ul>
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- The submission made by the **representative of the concerned college** was placed before the designated hearing committee and hearing committee sought clarification regarding the shortcomings mentioned in the denial order dated 15.11.2022. In response of the same, the Chairman, Sanskar Shiksha Samiti, VPO-Sunderpur, The-Behat, Dist-Saharanpur-247662, Uttar Pradesh vide its letter dated 28.11.2022 submitted the documents i.e. The College has submitted the Punjab National Bank statement of Trust namely Sanskar Shiksha Samiti for the period of 24 months (05.04.2020 to 31.10.2021). However, the Salary disbursement statement and the Salary Acquaintance register were not submitted by the college. The College authorities have not submitted the joining letter and relieving letter of Dr. Maheshwar Dash and Dr.G.C Pachauri.
- Hence, in view of above, hearing committee recommended not to consider the appeal of The Chairman Sanskar Shiksha Samiti, V.P.O. Sunderpur Tanko, Tehsil Behat, Distt. Saharanpur-247662 Uttar Pradesh to establish new Ayurveda medical college in the name of Saharanpur Ayurved Medical College, VPO-Sansarpur, Tehsil-Behat, Dist-Saharanpur-247129, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID AYU0733) with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2022-23 and as per direction of the Chairperson, NCISM your appeal was dismissed and same was communicated to you vide letter even no. dated 09.01.2023.
- Further, a request vide ref. no SSS/BAMS/07/2022-23 dated 13.01.2023 and SSS/BAMS/New/09/2022-23 dated 16.01.2023 was received in the commission to reconsider the decision of appeal as some documents submitted were not opened due to technical error.

The matter was placed before Chairman, NCISM and Chairman, NCISM directed to consider the request and again go through the submission. The same hearing committee went through the submission and the observation of the committee is as under:

**Observation of hearing committee: -**

- The committee asked the Principal, Dr. Deepak Deshpande, the details of the previous Medical superintendent of the institution, and he said that Dr. Maheshwar Dash was Medical superintendent from 1/8/2019 to 31/12/2019 and from 1/1/2020 to 31/12/2020 Dr. G.C Pachauri was the Medical superintendent. The committee asked to submit the joining letter and relieving letter of Dr. Maheshwar Dash and Dr. G.C Pachauri.
- The committee asked for the hospital attendance register of November 2019; they showed it. The committee asked, through which mode salary is paid to the staff and in response they informed that the Sanskar Shiksha Samiti is paying the salary through bank and the committee asked to submit the details of the same.
- Further, the committee asked the college principal to submit the attendance register from 1/11/2019 to 31/10/2021, their Individual salary statement from bank, joining letters, relieving letters if any, of all hospital staff.
- The College has submitted the Punjab National Bank statement of Trust namely Sanskar Shiksha Samiti for the period of 24 months (01/11/2019 to 31/10/2021). Also, the Salary disbursement statement and the Salary Acquaintance register was submitted by the college. The submission was verified and can be considered.
- Individual salary paid bank passbook details of 76 hospital staffs for the period (01/11/2019 to 31/10/2021) has submitted by the college and after verification it is found that 8 individual statements are incomplete. However, the submission can be considered.
- The College authority has submitted the joining letter of all staffs and the joining letter as well as relieving letter of Dr. Maheshwar Dash and Dr. G.C Pachauri. The submission was verified and can be considered.

Further, on the basis of due course of hearing and submission of documents by the college during the hearing, committee recommended to consider the appeal of The Chairman Sanskar Shiksha Samiti, Saharanpur, Uttar Pradesh under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 against the denial of LOI for intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2022-23. **The recommendation of hearing committee was placed before Chairman, National Commission for Indian System of Medicine and it has been decided by the Chairperson, NCISM to approve the decision of hearing committee and to consider the appeal of applicant.**

6. Hence, in view of the recommendation of hearing committee and on the basis of submission made by the college vide letter dated 13.01.2023 and 16.01.2023, the Chairman, NCISM directed the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM vide no. **NCISM/Comm./Appeal/(2022-23) (U.P) dated 17.02.2023 to issue Letter of Intent to the Chairman, Sanskar Shiksha Samiti, VPO-Sunderpur, The-Behat, Dist-Saharanpur-247662, Uttar Pradesh to establish new Ayurveda Medical College in the name of Saharanpur Ayurved Medical College, VPO-Sansarpur, Tehsil-Behat, Dist-Saharanpur-247129, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID-AYU0733) with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 from the academic session 2022-23.**
7. Therefore, in view of above as per direction of Chairman, NCISM to issue Letter of Intent to **The Chairman, Sanskar Shiksha Samiti, VPO-Sunderpur, The-Behat, Dist-Saharanpur-247662, Uttar Pradesh to establish new Ayurveda Medical College in the name of Saharanpur Ayurved Medical College, VPO-Sansarpur, Tehsil-Behat, Dist-Saharanpur-247129, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID-AYU0733) with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 from the academic session 2022-23** subject to the conditions that following conditions shall be fulfilled before issuance of Letter of permission (LOP) for the academic session 2022-23, failing which the Letter of Permission (LOP) shall not be issued and Letter of Intent (LOI) issued shall be deemed to be withdrawn.
  - i. The applicant shall fulfill all the requirements of infrastructure for teaching and training facilities as specified in "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016.
  - ii. The applicant shall fulfill all the relevant provisions of Regulations namely the "Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2019.
  - iii. The applicant shall fulfill all the requirements of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016.
  - iv. The applicant shall fulfill all the relevant provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020.
8. The applicant is also need to submit the requisite fixed security deposit as specified under the section 6 (1) (i) (i) of notified Regulations namely the "Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2019" **on demand before issuance of Letter of Permission (LOP).**
9. The college administration is to ensure that no student is admitted in the UG course till the formal permission i.e. Letter of Permission (LOP) is granted.
10. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) will visit the college virtually, physically or Hybrid mode to verify the compliance/ fulfillment of the above conditions by the applicant and issuing/not issuing the LOP will be considered.
11. In the event, the applicant college fails to comply with or satisfy the conditions of the Letter of Intent; the Letter of Intent shall be deemed to have been withdrawn without further intimation to the applicant.
